She serves on several boards including, NCE Pharmaceuticals, Inc., Planned Parenthood of San Diego, Riverside and Imperial Counties, and Project Wildlife.

Larry Trammell has an extensive executive background in the aerospace and government services industry. He was the first employee of the Technology Services Company of SAIC in 1987 and served as its General Manager from 1989 - 2005. During his time as the leader of the Technology Services Company, the business grew to over \$4 billion in revenues. Larry serves on the boards for several private companies including Tech Flow, a San Diego-based IT company. He is also on the Board of the Contract Services Association of America (CSA), serving as its Chairman in 1999, 2000, 2005 and 2006.

Frank Creede is currently the CTO of Pacific DataVision, Inc. where he leads the company's development of Push-to-Talk wireless applications. He was formerly the Chairman, President, & CEO of Logic Innovations, Inc., which was acquired by U.K. based Xyratex Ltd., the former division of IBM, in 1999. He is an active angel investor in Southern California emerging high tech companies, a Board Member of the San Diego Tech Coast Angels and a Partner and Founder of Staffing Innovations, LLC.

Rod Bolton has wide-ranging leadership experience gained in a 25-year span of profit and loss responsibility while serving as President of Teal Corporation, President for APW Electronics Solutions, and Vice President and General Manager of Elpac Electronics, Inc. He has served on the board of the San Diego Chamber of Commerce, on the national board of the American Electronics Association (AEA) and has held the position of President and Chairman of the San Diego board of the AEA. He currently serves on several boards including ITECH Corporation and Versacall.
